



## Field Technician– CCTV CDL Driver

### POSITION

Field Technician – CCTV & CDL - Operator

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Sets up, drives, and operates various equipment in the performance of daily operations.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Load and prepare equipment for upcoming jobs. Unload equipment upon arrival on the job. Re-load equipment upon completion of the job and unload equipment upon return to the shop. This includes lifting, carrying and pulling equipment of various size, shape and weight.
- Set up and operate sewer cleaning equipment, high-pressure water jet and positive displacement vacuum system trucks. This includes lifting, carrying and pulling hoses of up to 100 lbs, climbing on to the unit (12' high) for set up and minor maintenance, standing, kneeling or bending for long periods of time.
- Drive any and all vehicles as needed including those with manual and automatic transmissions.
- Set up and operate various hand held and hand operated equipment including power tools, shovels etc.
- Majority of duties take place outside with exposure to all types of weather conditions and terrain on a year-round basis. May be exposed to hazardous materials including raw sewage, noise, fumes, chemicals, etc.
- Operates mobile television and chemical sealing units to conduct internal sewer line inspections and to seal defects, thereby preventing water infiltration.
- Places traffic cones and other barricades at job sites; removes manhole covers and examines manhole to determine proper set-up procedure.
- Locates line sections to be inspected, using map, and determines set up procedures; sets up winches, determines skid size and installs proper skid; plugs line, if necessary; threads cable through sewer lines and places camera inside manhole to televise sewer line;
- Operates and adjusts camera controls to obtain optimum clarity and contrast. Prepares description of each sewer defect, and records pertinent data.
- Determines supplies necessary for the daily operation of the T.V. truck and equipment; assists with mixing chemicals.
- Prepares packer, connects necessary cables to packer operates sealing unit to release sealing compound.
- Removes camera, hoses and packing from line when inspection or sealing operations completed. Cleans and stores camera, chemicals, and equipment on van truck after use.
- Emergency on-call response after normal work hours is required
- Responsible for his/her own on the job safety and work quality.
- Drive waste hauling vehicles.
- Perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections in accordance with FMCSR guidelines.
- Maintain Hours of Service logs (when required) accurate and up to date.
- Identify and ensure write-ups of defective equipment on trucks.
- Ensure professional and safe operation of vehicles while on customer property and over the road.
- Wash trucks internally when directed.
- Wash truck/trailer exterior as needed.
- Perform minor maintenance functions on trucks as needed while on the road.
- Support and comply with all components of Loss Preventions System (LPS)
- Regular and physical attendance is an essential function of this position

#### KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS

- Good math skills
- Must be thoroughly familiar with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations
- Must be familiar with Hazardous Materials Transportation Regulations
- Must be able to work with little guidance and supervision
- Clean driving record as determined by the Company's current auto insurance carrier
- Must possess Group A or B CDL with X and Air Brake endorsements for operation of vehicles.
- Herbicide/pesticide applicators license may be required

#### PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must successfully complete a Respirator certification physical examination
- Must pass DOT physical for operation of commercial motor vehicles
- Must pass Hazardous Waste Operations physical as defined by 29CFR1910.120
- Able to wear a respirator
- Able to stand, sit and walk for long periods of time
- Able to bend at the waist to reach within 6" of the ground and reach overhead
- Able to climb ladders and stairs without difficulty
- Must have manual dexterity sufficient for use of small hand tools, handling of small parts (e.g. nuts/bolts), and working with hands at various positions (e.g. overhead, front, low)
- No medical condition or impairment which would place the employee at increased risk in the event of an exposure to chemical agents
- No psychological or physical impairments that may present a safety risk to the employee and co-workers
- Able to lift, carry, push and pull equipment weighing up to 100 lbs with another employee's assistance
- Must be able to work in extreme temperature conditions, in confined areas and at heights in excess of 30 feet
- Good vision and hearing
- Drug free
- Able to read, write, understand and speak English

#### EDUCATIONAL / CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Truck Driving Certification or 2-5 years related experience
- Minimum of 1 year experience in municipal or environmental field
- High School Diploma or GED
